How I Spent My Summer. Moro?lu Arseven Associate Pelin O?uzer Reflects on Her Secondment with Germany's Friedrich Graf von Westphalen

O?uzer said the experience helped her to understand how foreign lawyers approach similar processes such as drafting and negotiating commercial contracts. She said it was also interesting to see their work routine and observe their process of planning a project and the way they delegate the duties within a team, which was slightly different than what she was used to.

"At the end of my secondment, I gave a presentation to about 15 lawyers from FGvW on Turkish sales law," she said. "We also had a 20-30 minute Q&A session on sales law, compensation of damages and other remedies, choice of law issues in contracts and general questions on Turkish law of contracts as well as settlement of disputes in Turkey."
